

## SHIRAZ CABERNET 2007

**Production:** 100 Cases

**Bottled:** Winter 2009

**Released:** Autumn 2010

**Oak:** New French Barriques

**Region:** McLaren Vale

**Vineyard:** Clarendon - Shiraz 65% Willunga - Cabernet 35%

**Colour:** Rich vibrant cherry colour

**Aroma:** Initially a heady aroma of maraschino cherry, mulberries and blueberries, although there is a floral lift which combines with the smoky, cedary French oak to suggest a wine of power and complexity.

**Palate:** Cherries, mocha, chocolate, in fact cherry ripe springs to mind, firm backbone but velvety tannin takes over. Summer fruits reappear, followed by complexing elements of black olive, liquorice, clove and cinnamon that emerge on a prolonged finish.

**Drink:** 1-15 years

**Food:** Now with a Prime Rib of Beef or Kangaroo on a bed of creamy polenta.
